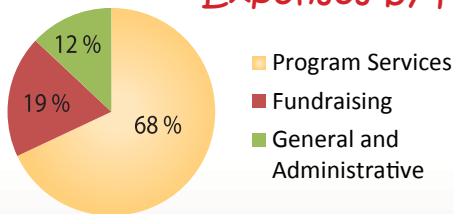

	Children Served	Program Information
	173 children 1,938 room nights	The Reno Ronald McDonald House is a 12 bedroom home-away-from-home for families with children in the hospital. To stay at the House, families must live at least 30 miles from Reno.
	257 children 1,028 appointments	A mobile outreach clinic granted to our medical partner, The Community Health Alliance, to provide medical and dental care, health education and other services to children.
	105 students	Encourages students to continue their education by giving four year scholarships to northern Nevada high school seniors.
	26 children 91 trips	The Travel-for-Treatment program gives parents financial assistance when a child's medical treatment is not available at a hospital close to home.
	311 children 3,713 visits to the room	A comfortable and supportive space for families with a child in Renown Children's Hospital. In the Family Room, families can rest and regroup just moments away from their sick child.

Helping Families Find Strength in Numbers.

- **52,138:** Nights families have spent in the Reno Ronald McDonald House since 1987.
- **25:** The Reno Ronald McDonald House celebrated its 25th anniversary in 2012.
- **3,713:** Visits to the Ronald McDonald Family Room since it opened in February 2012
- **255:** Average number of miles Travel-for-Treatment families have to travel for their child's medical care.
- **105,000:** The Ronald McDonald Care Mobile has provided over 105,000 free appointments to Nevada's children.
- **637:** Students from Nevada have received a RMHC Scholarship.
- **\$834,850:** Awarded to RMHC Scholarship recipients since 2000.
- **7,300:** Over 7,300 families have stayed at the Reno Ronald McDonald House.
